## Covid Outbreak Plan

If you attend a church event or visit either church office and then test positive for Covid 19 let the office know. If there is a Covid case at a church event the Senior Leadership Team will assess the risk of exposure that occurred and decide if a return to any previous control measures is appropriate.

- Sanitise your hands on arrival in our buildings.
- Wear a mask whilst moving around the space and while singing if possible.
- Maintain social distancing – if possible it is still best to drink outside! We will provide a coffee station in the garden weather permitting

If you would prefer to maintain social distancing note that the 9am service is quieter and you are welcome to exit via the Wordsworth Chapel to avoid groups gathering at the coffee stations .

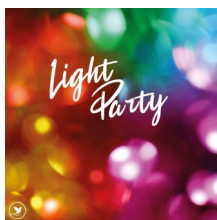
## Dates for your diary
