Luke 15.1-31 Three lost treasured possessions

1. Share an experience of when you lost something valuable, and how you handled it. What were your feelings at the time?
2. What does this tell us on how God our Father feels about losing precious prodigals? What does He do about it, and what part are we of His Plan?
3. What are the points of similarity and difference between these three parables? Why did Jesus need to reinforce his message three times?
4. Presumably none of us is above the need to respond to Jesus' teaching. When asked with whom you more closely identified, was it with the Scribes and Pharisees, or with the tax collectors and sinners?
5. Did you agree that we are all on the same journey as the Prodigal Son?
5. Maybe some members of the group can share how you can identify as you have travelled with The Prodigal on this boomerang journey away from The Lord, but now to have turned around and to be Home-bound.
6. Home Group members may wish to share their own experience of having Prodigals in their families and the narrative so far. Then maybe all can pray into these real time, real life stories.
